



Internal Academic Policy

Enrollment Duration, Credit Completion, and Transcript Integrity

Purpose

This policy defines the School's internal academic standards regarding enrollment duration, credit completion, and issuance of academic records. The policy ensures instructional sufficiency, academic integrity, and transcript credibility.

Legal Context (State of Florida)

Florida law does not establish a mandatory minimum enrollment period for students enrolled in private or online schools. At the same time, Florida law grants private schools academic autonomy and assigns responsibility to schools for the validity and accuracy of academic records.

This policy is adopted consistent with Florida Statutes §§1002.42, 1003.02, and 1003.25.

Academic Autonomy and Institutional Responsibility

As a private online school registered in the State of Florida, the School is responsible for ensuring that academic credits reflect sustained instructional participation, grades are based on documented coursework and assessment, and transcripts represent genuine academic progress.

Minimum Enrollment Period

The School requires a minimum enrollment period before issuing official transcripts, confirming grade-level completion, or recognizing academic credits as earned. This requirement is an internal academic policy and is not a statutory mandate.

Credit-Based Tuition Model

Tuition is credit-based and not unlimited by time. Annual enrollment includes a defined number of academic credits as specified in the enrollment agreement. Completion of all included credits prior to the end of the enrollment term does not entitle a student to additional credits without additional tuition.

Early Completion and Continued Enrollment

Students who complete all included credits ahead of schedule may retain access to the learning platform for review, enrichment activities, or non-credit coursework. Access to additional credited courses requires separate enrollment or purchase of additional credits.

Credit Recognition and Transcript Issuance

Academic credits are officially recognized only after the minimum enrollment period has been satisfied and all academic requirements have been completed. Credits completed prior to the minimum enrollment period are considered credits in progress and validated upon completion of all requirements.

Equal Application

This policy applies uniformly to all students regardless of nationality, residency, or prior educational background.
