



Subject: Enrollment Duration and Credit Recognition Policy

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your careful attention to the academic and legal aspects of your child's education.

Florida law does not require a specific minimum enrollment period for students enrolled in private or online schools. However, Florida law grants schools academic autonomy and places responsibility on schools for the validity and credibility of academic records.

Accordingly, our School applies a minimum enrollment period and a credit-based tuition model consistent with standard practices among established Florida-based online schools.

If a student completes all included credits ahead of schedule, the student may continue enrichment or review activities. Additional credited coursework requires separate academic enrollment or purchase.

These policies ensure fairness, academic integrity, and long-term recognition of academic records.
